Since the publication of this volume in 1994, four of the Schøyen's manuscripts listed above have been sold to Yale University Library (MSS 671, 689, 725 and 1560). A further three (MSS 10, 33 and 1641) have gone to anonymous

buyers. In 2005 Schøyen sold MS 194 to Senshu University in Japan; it is now Senshu MS 1. Schøyen still owns MSS 673, 1355, 1371 and 1701 (Martin Schøyen, pers. comm. September 2014).
